Information for universities regarding the school's approach to linearity at A Level

This school is following a fully linear A Level course. We expect and encourage the majority of our students to sit only 3 A Level subjects (a small minority take 4 A Levels), in order that they have enough space to supplement these 3 core A Level specialisms with independent study and research, or an additional GCSE, an AS Level taken over 2 years or an EPQ. They sit internal examinations at the end of Year 12, which are externally moderated by a group of 4 Schools, Highgate School, City of London School, University College School and St Albans High School, to ensure that the assessment is rigorous and robust.
