MOBILE PHONES Y7-11

- Phones are not permitted for use at School by any pupil in Y7-11 between the hours of 08.15 and 16:00
- Any phone brought in must be placed in locker on arrival and be switched to DND. Apple watches must also be on DND during the School Day.
- In an emergency, pupils go to Reception, where parents can be called from the School landline. All other communication can be done via iPad, Teams or Email.
- There are no mobile phone points to allow for phone use.
- Pupils need to load their School ID card (WisePay) to use in Café / carry a debit card.
- Year 11 may take their phone into St Albans town centre at lunchtime.

Y7-11 sanction for mobile phone use in School: confiscation and straight Monday Detention.

- 1. Ask pupil to turn the phone off. Inform them they will receive a detention and can collect the phone at the end of the day from Mrs Carro in Deputy Head's office.
- 2. Place the mobile in a confiscation envelope.
- 3. Bring to Lorena Carro.

MOBILE PHONES Y12-13

- Phones are permitted in the Sixth Form Centre.
- Phones are not permitted to be out in the main school and should not be seen in corridors. This also applies to ear pods.

- Sixth Form may use their phone to purchase food from the café.
- If they are seen using their phone in the main school building, it should be confiscated and taken to the Sixth Form Office.
