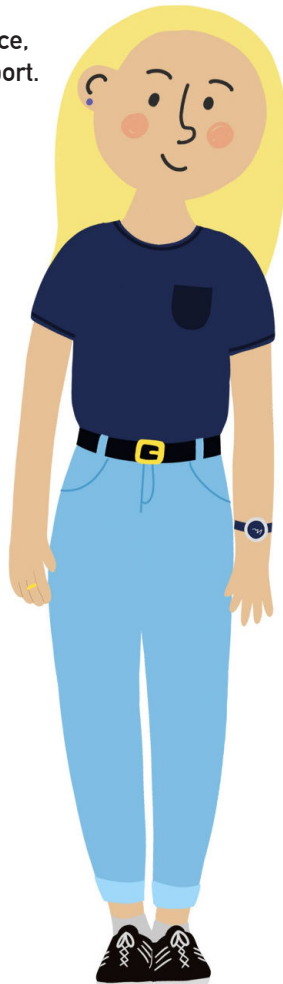


Sixth Form Dress Code

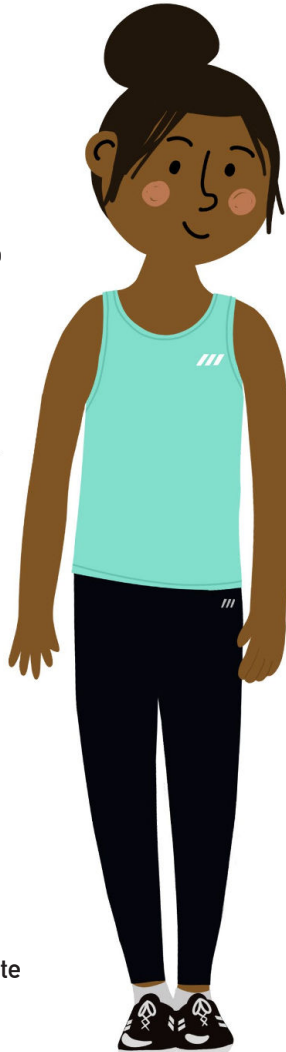
