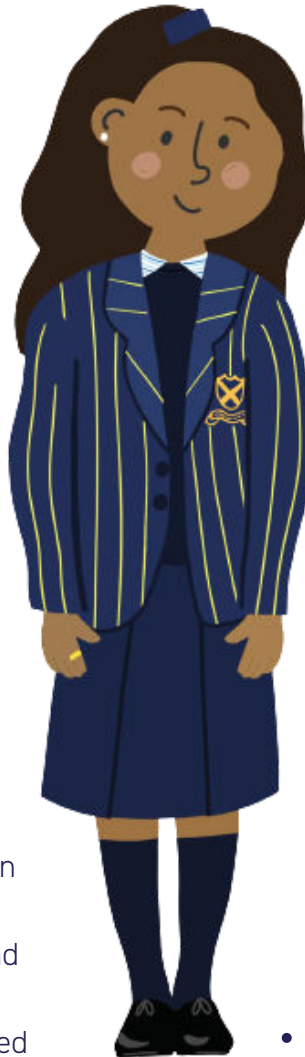


# YEAR 7-11 SCHOOL UNIFORM

- Hair tied up for practical subjects: Science, DT, Art, Drama, Music, Sport (with navy, black, brown or natural hair tie). Teachers may also request that hair is tied up at other times for health and safety reasons.
- Hair colour and make up should all be in natural colours. No nail varnish.
- School shirt (winter) or school blouse (summer).
- Blazers and Lanyard to be worn at all times.
- Optional: Coat, plain and dark in colour. To be put in locker on arrival to School. Hats, caps and bandanas can be worn to and from School but should be placed in lockers on arrival.



- Pupils are welcome to wear religious head-coverings, in navy blue or black.
- Navy blue jumper or sweat-shirt (optional). No hoodies. No labels or branding.
- Jewellery is worn at owner's risk: one set of stud earrings (must be stud, not hoop) which must be able to be removed for PE. One necklace or chain carrying a religious pendant no larger than 2cm in length. One ring and a watch are permitted.
- Stevensons navy blue school skirt (to sit just above the knee) worn with non-laddered tights (if required on cold days). Navy blue trousers may also be worn.
- Navy blue or black tights/socks.
- Plain black shoes, fastened by Velcro or laces (not heels, trainers or ballet flats). No branding must be visible on shoes.

\*If School Uniform cannot be worn for medical or any other reason, a blue Uniform Exemption card will be issued. Please request this from your Tutor/Assistant Housemistress/Housemistress. Spare plimsols, jumpers, tights, hair ties and nail varnish remover are held in offices of all Housemistresses and the Deputy Head Pastoral.

# YEAR 7-11 PE KIT

- Hair tied up (with navy, black, brown or natural hair tie).
- No jewellery. All piercings to be removed.
- No false or long nails.
- School navy and yellow socks or white sports socks.
- Appropriate exercise trainers e.g. (but not limited to) no Converse, Plimsolls, Green Flash or Nike Air Force.



- School navy blue shirt (school baselayer top in winter). Additional layers, for warmth, consist of the school navy waterproof jacket and then a STAHS bench jacket.
- School navy blue games skirt.
- Sports base layer leggings or school navy blue tracksuit bottoms must be worn to all academic lessons during the school day and when moving around between lessons for health and safety reasons. Legs may be uncovered for Sport and for walking to and from Sport on warm days at teacher discretion.

\*If School Uniform cannot be worn for medical or any other reason, a blue Uniform Exemption card will be issued. Please request this from your Tutor/Assistant Housemistress/Housemistress. PE kit must be brought in on days where PE or Games lessons show on the timetable. Changing time is built into the start of each PE or Games lesson.
